**ALL WINTER ACTIVITY PARTICIPANTS MUST:**

- Do so at their own risk.
- Must stay off of private property.
- Must not chase wildlife.
- Must stay off of ponds, greens, or tees. Greens will be marked by colored rope.
- Must stay clear of all hazards on the courses, including but not limited to: boulders, water, ditches, etc...
- Must follow restrictions/ordinances the Town of Star Valley Ranch has in regards to the roadways and Town property.
- Should be alert and aware of others using the course.

**Snowmobiling:**

All snowmobiles:

- Are required to have a SVRA Snowmobile Permit. Cost of permit shall be determined with the annual fee schedule.
- Are encouraged to stay on Aspen Hills & the SVRA airstrip property
  - Snowmobiles are allowed on the outer edge of all sledding hills for transport only. This includes but not limited to Aspen Hills #1 and #5.
- Must stay off the groomed snowshoe and cross-country ski trails.
- Must yield to persons sledding, cross country skiing and snowshoeing, as they have the right of way.
- Must end your snowmobiling day on the courses by 9 p.m.

2 feet of snow and a solid base are required before snowmobiles are allowed on the course. Adequate snow depth and base to be determined by the Golf Course Superintendent and the General Manager.

Star Valley Ranch Association shall post restrictions and availability on the marquees, social media, website, and email as needed and appropriate.

**Cross-Country Skiing and Snowshoeing:**

Trails will be groomed as weather and staffing permit.

**Sledding and Tubing:**

Aspen Hills #1 is groomed for sledding and tubing.

**Ice Skating:**

Ice skating rink will be placed at Cedar Creek Park. Rink will be created, cleaned, and maintained as weather and staffing permit.
