Park, a Nevada limited partnership, by and through its sole General Partner, Star Valley Ranch R. V. Park, Inc., a Nevada corporation, ("Leisure Valley") for valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby assign, convey and quitclaim to Star Valley Ranch Association, a Wyoming nonprofit corporation, having its principal place of business in Lincoln County, Wyoming, ("Association") all of their right, title and interest in and to the following Permits to Appropriate Surface Water issued by the Office of the State Engineer, State of Wyoming:

- 1. Permit No. 28143, for the Stewart Pipeline with a priority date of the 9th day of September, 1982.
- 2. Permit No. 6973 Enl., for the First Enlargement of the Stewart Pipeline with a priority date of the 16th day of July, 1987.
- 3. Permit No. 6974 Enl., for the Second Enlargement of the Stewart Pipeline with a priority date of the 8th day of September, 1989.

Pursuant to Paragraph 11 of the Final Settlement Agreement dated August / , 1998, Leisure Valley's domestic/culinary water system will be fully and completely separated by the Association from the Association's domestic/culinary water system on or before November 1, 2000 (the "Separation Date"). The parties to this Assignment understand and agree that Leisure Valley shall have the right to and shall continue to use water from the permits assigned by this Assignment until the Separation Date.
