

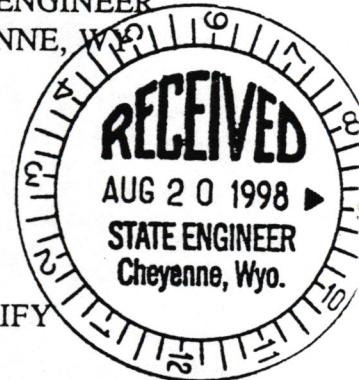

MOTION TO WITHDRAW PETITION TO AMEND AND CLARIFY

WHEREAS, Leisure Valley, Inc., d/b/a/ Star Valley Ranch R.V. Park, submitted the above-entitled Petition to Amend and Clarify Points of Use under Permit No. 28143 and 6973 Enl., and

WHEREAS, Leisure Valley, Inc. has assigned all of its right, title and interest in and to Permit No. 28143 for the Stewart Pipeline and Permit No. 6973 Enl. for the First Enlargement of the Stewart Pipeline to the Star Valley Ranch Association, a Wyoming nonprofit corporation, ("Association") having its principal place of business in Lincoln County, Wyoming, by a certain "Assignment of Permits to Appropriate Surface Water" dated August 10, 1998 ("Assignment"), and

WHEREAS, Leisure Valley, Inc. and the Association have entered into a Final Settlement Agreement dated August 10, 1998 which provides at Paragraph 11:

Leisure Valley presently obtains a portion of its domestic/culinary water from Prater Canyon Well No. 1 (because of a cross connection pipe) and from the Stewart Pipeline through the Association's domestic/culinary water system by way of a connection to Leisure Valley's water system located in the N.W. corner of the Star Valley Ranch R.V. Park main entrance on the east side of Muddy String Road.

The parties agree that Leisure Valley's domestic/culinary water system shall be fully and completely separated by the Association from the Association's domestic/culinary water system as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than November 1, 2000 (the "Separation Date"). On the Separation Date, the Association shall terminate providing domestic/culinary water to Leisure Valley and

Leisure Valley's domestic/culinary water system and water supply shall be totally and forever separated from the Association's domestic/culinary water system, storage facilities, distribution system and water supply, and

WHEREAS, the Assignment provides in relevant part:

Pursuant to Paragraph 11 of the Final Settlement Agreement dated August 10, 1998, Leisure Valley's domestic/culinary water system will be fully and completely separated by the Association from the Association's domestic/culinary water system on or before November 1, 2000 (the "Separation Date"). The parties to this Assignment understand and agree that Leisure Valley shall have the right to and shall continue to use water from the permits assigned by this Assignment until the Separation Date, and

WHEREAS, upon and after the Separation Date, Leisure Valley, Inc. will have no interest in Permit No. 28143 for the Stewart Pipeline and Permit No. 6973 Enl. for the First Enlargement of the Stewart Pipeline.

NOW THEREFORE, Leisure Valley, Inc. withdraws the above-entitled Petition and moves the Board to enter an order of withdrawal, said Order to be effective upon the Separation Date.
